According to the Ferguson TEA-20 "Tractor Service Instruction Book," the tractor will travel at 9 3/4 mph at 1500 rpm. That should equate to 13 mph at maximum rated engine speed of 2000 rpm. That means your tractor should not be capable of reaching 18 mph, much less exceeding that speed. Bob</p>
